Principal Duties:

- Responsible for Month-End closing procedures including costing utilities, generating and posting manufacturing journals, calendar maintenance and general journal entries.
- Oversee the maintenance of the general and subsidiary ledgers including the Chart of Accounts for Verathon Inc. and Verathon Medical Inc. including review of all postings and preparation of monthly balance sheet account reconciliations.
- Key liaison to internal and external auditors.
- Ensure compliance with internal controls and company accounting policies and procedures.
- Provide assistance and/or training to foreign subsidiaries as needed.
- Program administrator for Concur expense reporting system, Wells Fargo company credit cards program, Kronos Timekeeping system and FAS (Fixed Asset Software).
- Assist in manufacturing cost accounting including developing cost standards and reporting on variances.
- Develop and maintain key reports for reporting performance; key accounting liaison to IT for system problems or improvements.
- Prepare internal management summary reports.
- Perform other related duties as assigned.
